## Admission

Application forms are available in our college website. Interested candidates can download the application forms with payment of Rs. 50/- UG, Rs. 60/- PG respectively. Separate application forms are to be submitted for each Programme. Filled in application forms along with Photocopies of the Mark Statements (+1 & +2), Transfer Certificate & Community Certificate should reach the office within 15 days from the publication of +2 Results.

In case of P.G. Programmes, the applicants can submit their application forms along with photo copies of the mark statements of the five semesters. If a Provisionally selected candidate fails to qualify in the sixth semester examination, the seat will be forfeited.
