The Governance of the Institution demonstrates effective leadership in line with its Vision and Mission.

Governing Body:

The Governing Body is the major decision making body with 24 members including the President, the Vice- President, the Secretary, the Treasurer, the Joint Secretary, the Principal and three other faculty members. The Governing Body meets periodically to decide strategies, policies, progression and future plans of the Institution.
